
Kingston University COVID Vaccination Clinic - Location & Patient Information

You have been invited by your GP Practice to come and have your COVID 19 vaccination. This will involve two separate vaccinations approximately 12 weeks apart.

The vaccination programme is being delivered jointly with a number of other GP Practices across Kingston from a single designated site. This site is the **John Galsworthy Building at Kingston University**, **Penrhyn Road campus**.

There is pedestrian access from the main entrance of the University on Penrhyn Road and parking is available at the rear of the University on Fassett Road which may be accessed either via Grove Crescent if approaching from Kingston or Beaufort Road if approaching from Surbiton. We also have some limited disabled parking spaces available in a separate car park for those requiring wheelchair assistance - for SatNav or Google maps please use postcode **KT1 2DD** for both car parks. They will be clearly signposted.

IMPORTANT: Please note that wherever possible you should NOT drive yourself to this appointment as you will not be able to drive for 15 minutes post vaccination.



Both car parks are a short walk from the Vaccination Clinic. There will be marshals on site to signpost you accordingly. If you require wheelchair assistance please let one of the marshals know and they will be happy to assist you.

Due to the volume of vaccines that need to be delivered in a short timescale it is important that you attend your appointment on time. Similarly owing to limited parking spaces **please do not arrive too early**. Upon arrival, we would ask that any relatives/friends who have brought you to your appointment remain in the car as we need to maintain social distancing within the Vaccination Clinic setting.

If you are coming by Bus, the **Kingston University/County Hall bus stop** on Penrhyn Road is a short walk from the main university entrance. The following buses stop here; **K2**, **K3**, **71**, **281**, **406** & **418**

Upon arrival you should follow directions given by the marshals, requesting assistance where necessary. We look froward to seeing you.
